



DONOR BILL OF RIGHTS  
The Christian Adulthood Initiative

Last Revised: February 4, 2021

All donors to the Christian Adulthood Initiative (CAI) have these rights:

- I. To be informed of the CAI's mission, vision, values, plans, intentions, and of its ability to use funds to carry those out.
- II. To be assured their gifts will only be used in pursuit of CAI's mission, never for personal or corporate gain.
- III. To be informed of who CAI's Board members, executive leaders, and staff are, and of the relationship to CAI of anyone who contacts them of behalf of CAI.
- IV. To receive clear, truthful answers to their questions about CAI.
- V. To be assured of prudent governance on the part of CAI's Board, and to be able to petition the Board toward the furtherance of that goal.
- VI. To have access to CAI's financial statements on request.
- VII. To receive an annual State of the Ministry report.
- VIII. To be assured that their information is handled with all legal confidentiality.
- IX. To have their names deleted from non-confidential mailing lists on request.
- X. To receive appropriate expressions of gratitude.
